



In 1924, one year of college work was added to the program offered by Pasadena High School and soon after another year was added. In 1928, Pasadena High School and Pasadena Junior College merged into a four-year junior college with grades 11-14 inclusive. A second four-year junior college, John Muir College, was organized in 1946. Pasadena Junior College's name was changed to Pasadena City College in 1947. In 1953, the two four-year junior colleges were combined into a single college, Pasadena City College, serving freshmen and sophomores. The Pasadena Area Junior College District formation was approved by the voters and became effective July 1, 1967. The name became Pasadena Area Community College District on September 10, 1970.
