## Exercise 7 - Color and Proportion

Test your understanding of how color placement and size of color can affect the overall perception of a color palette. Below is a palette of colors, each of a different hue, value, and chroma. Below that is a composition that serves as the various proportions for this exercise. This exercise is similar to Slide 5 of Chapter 7 Lecture PDF.

First, assign 3-5 colors from the options below to the composition and varying the locations. To do so, select a color or two colors and drag and drop them on top of the background. Click on the object to adjust the width and length to fit into the composition's shapes. Next, change only 1-2 colors from the first composition in the second composition. Repeat all other colors and their placement from the first composition into the second.

The 5 color selected (Red/Green and Yellow/Violet Complementaries plus Blue) and the 2 colors changed (Violet and Blue):
