

Tutorial: How to Check Spelling in InDesign

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Technique 1. To get problems of spelling errors, repeated words or capitilization highlighted

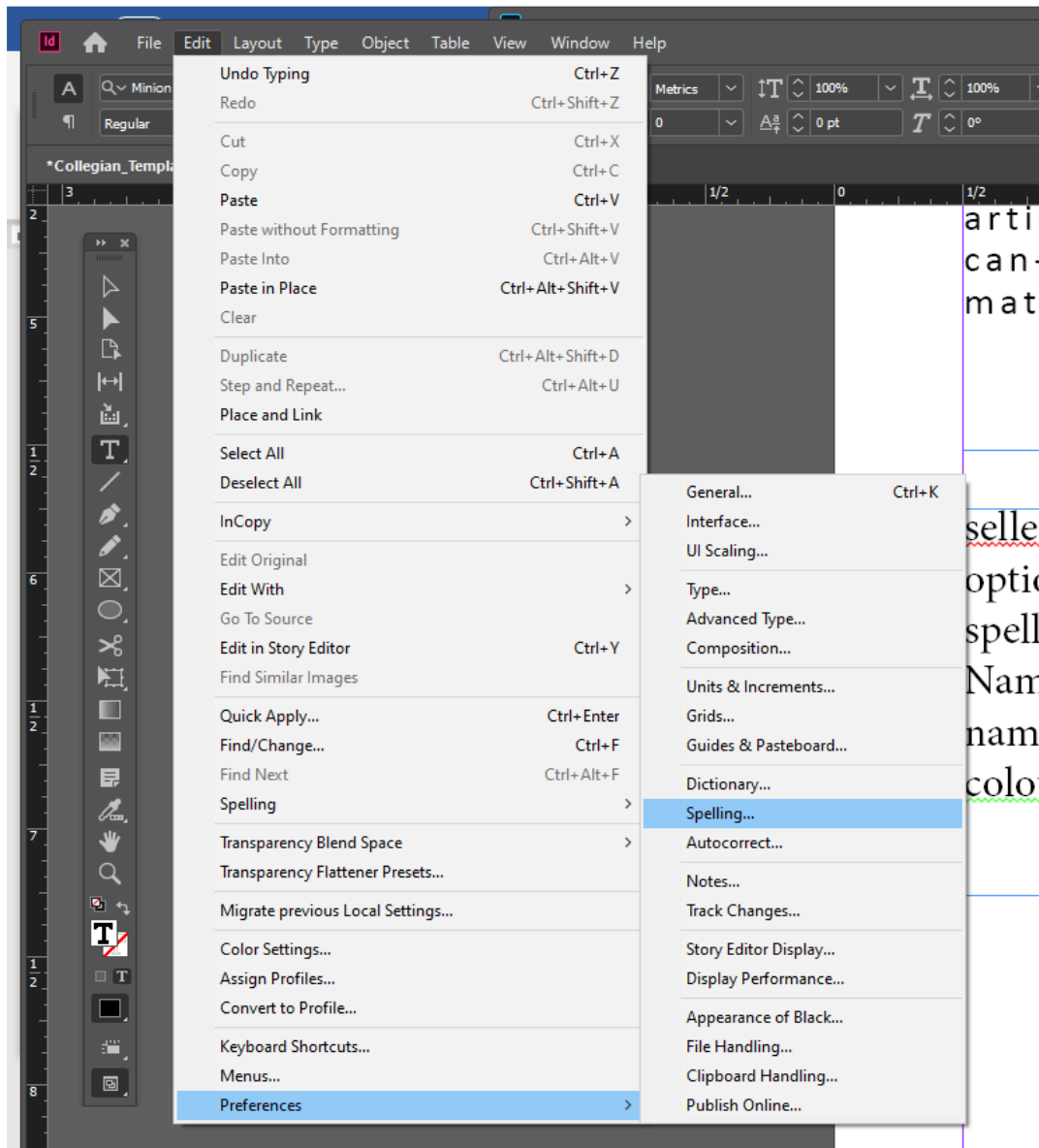


Figure 1A. The Edit→Preferences→Spelling menu.

Go to the Edit→Preferences→Spelling menu (*Figure 1A*) to open the Preferences menu, and select the Enable Dynamic Spelling option (*Figure 1B*); next, select underline colors for Misspelled words, Repeated words, Uncapitalized words, and Uncapitalized sentences if desired (*Figure 1C*).

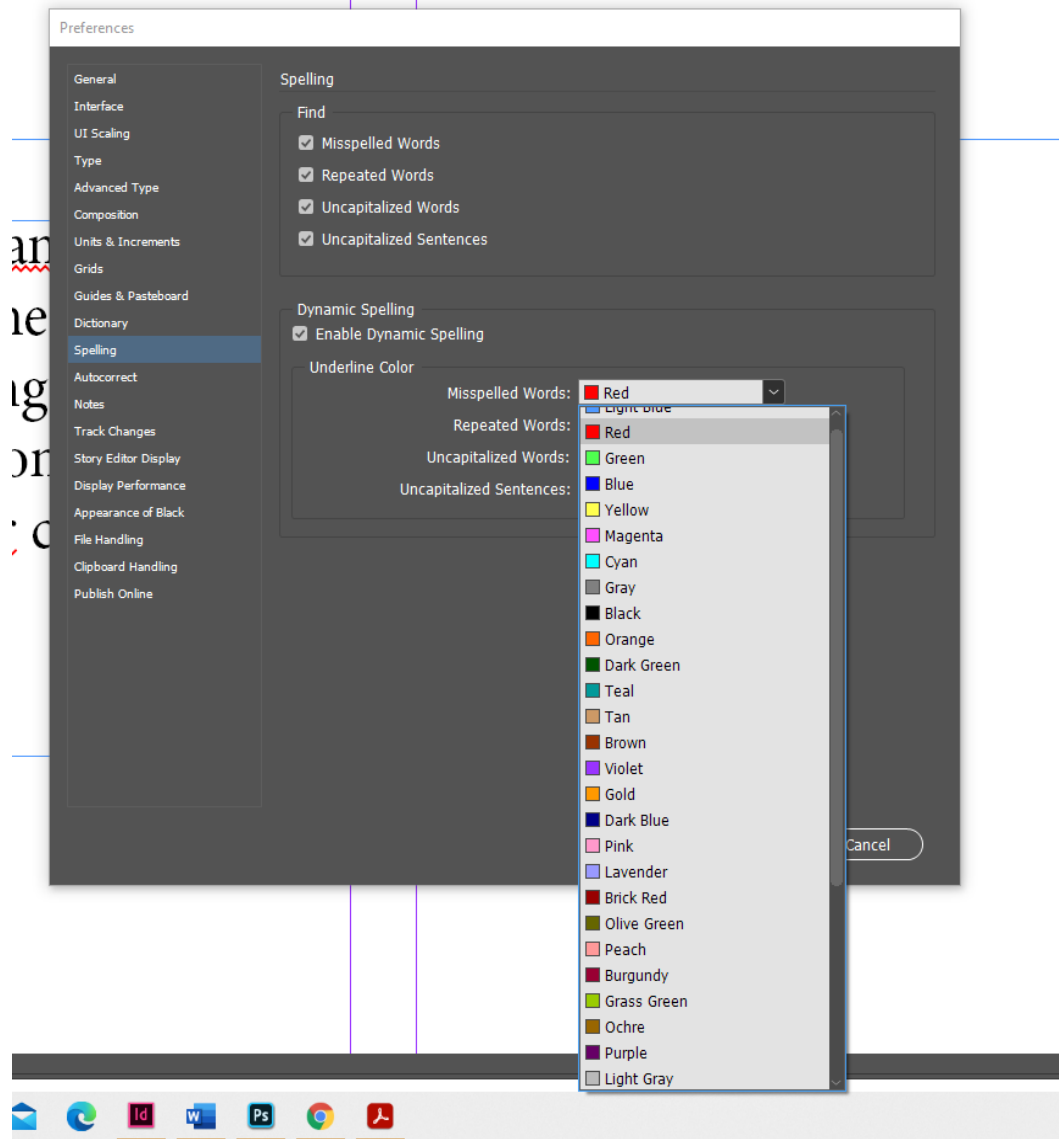


Figure 1B. Enable Dynamic Spelling option checked; selecting colors for Underline Color if needed.

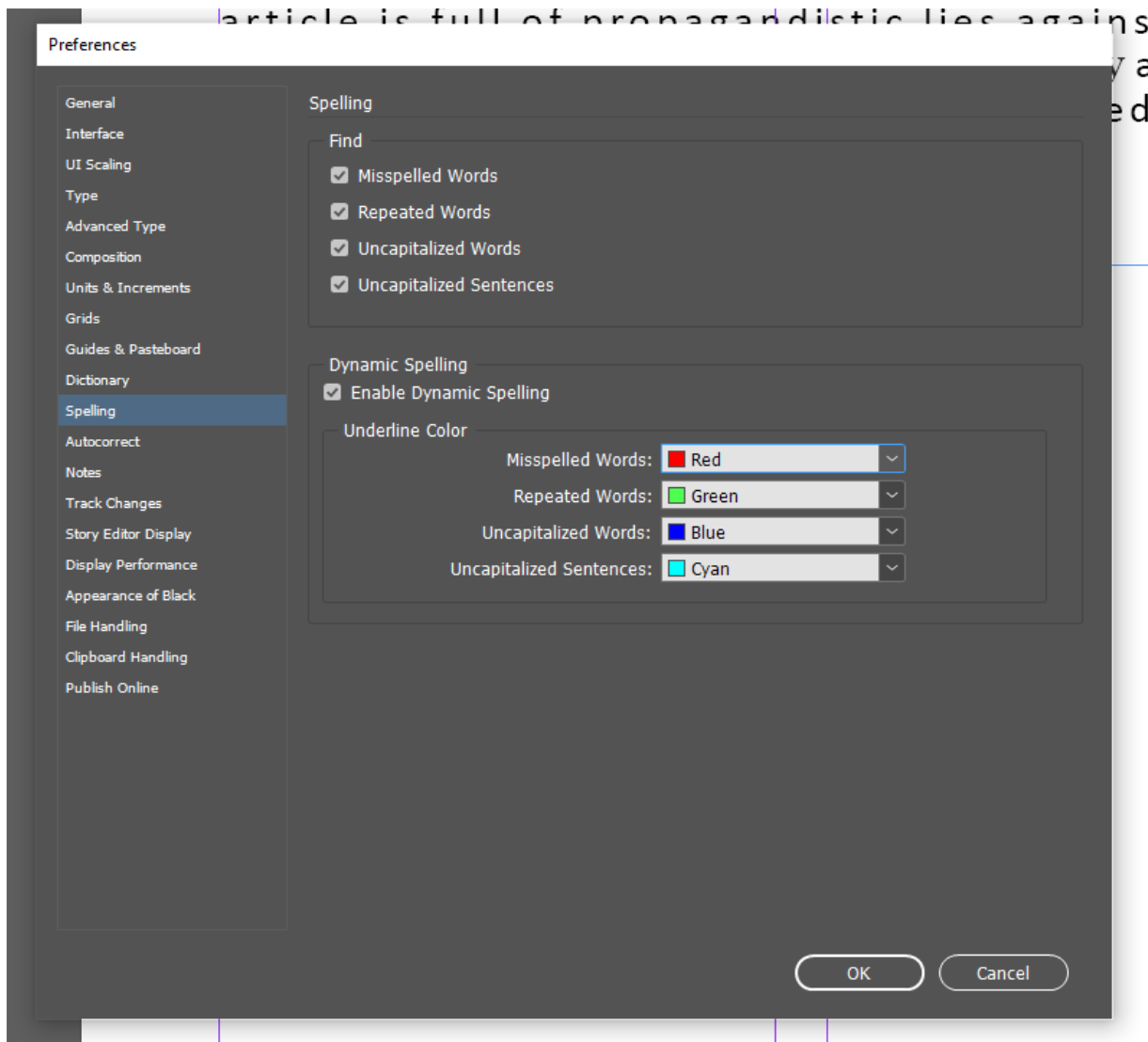


Figure 1C: Underline colors for Misspelled words, Repeated words, Uncapitalized words, and Uncapitalized sentences selected

Technique 2. To check the spelling of an existing paragraph

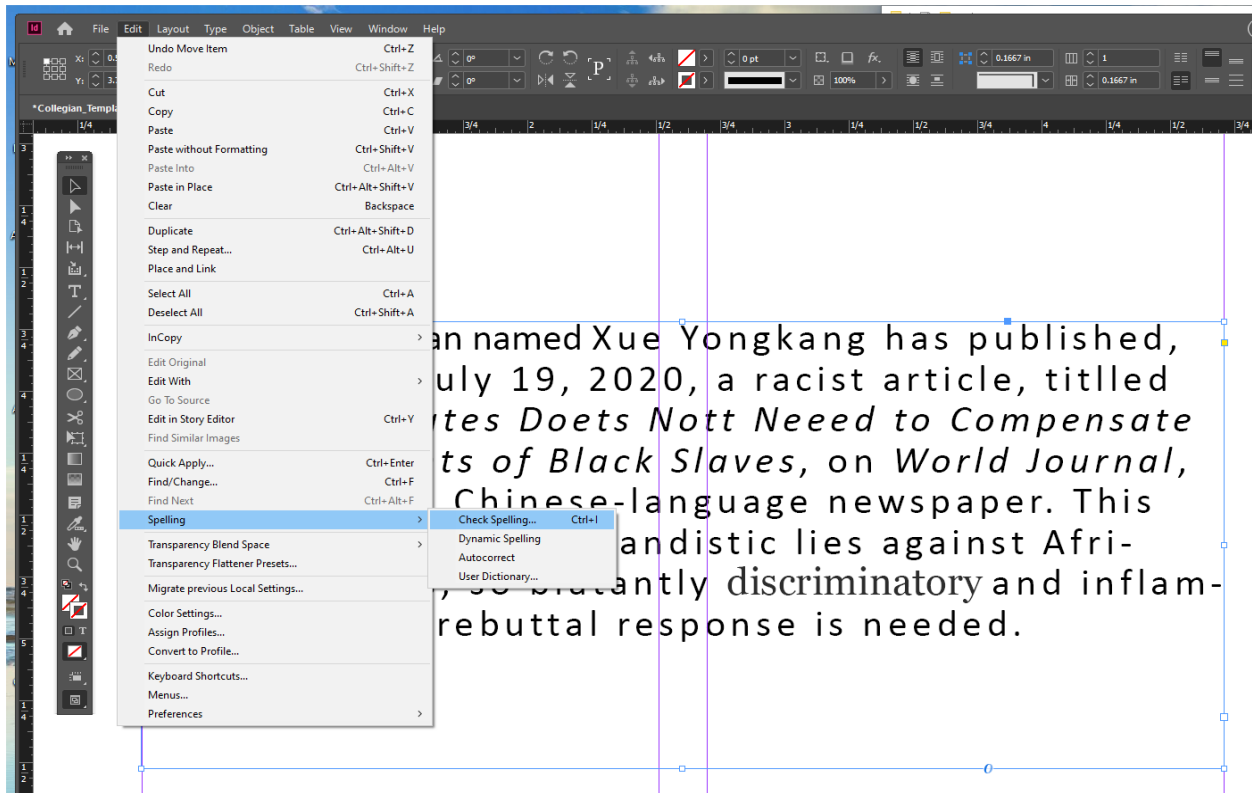


Figure 2A. The Edit → Spelling → Check Spelling menu.

First, select the textbox containing the paragraph, then go to the Edit→Spelling→Check Spelling menu to open the Check Spelling dialog box (*Figure 2A*); the dialog will list the word that is possibly spelled incorrectly under the heading “not in dictionary” and the correctly spelled word under the heading “Suggested Corrections;” if the word is actually spelled correctly, then click the “Skip” button to move to the next word suspected of misspelling (*Figure 2B*); otherwise, click the word that is correct and it will appear in the “Change to” text field; click the “Change” button or “Change All” button if there are several cases of the same mistake (*Figure 2C*); notice that the misspelled words are highlighted with black color in the text frame; repeat the process until all misspelled words are corrected and click the Done button to exit the dialog box (*Figure 2D*).

To zoom in or zoom out the screen, use the Ctrl and + or Ctrl and – key combination as shortcuts (for Window-based computers).

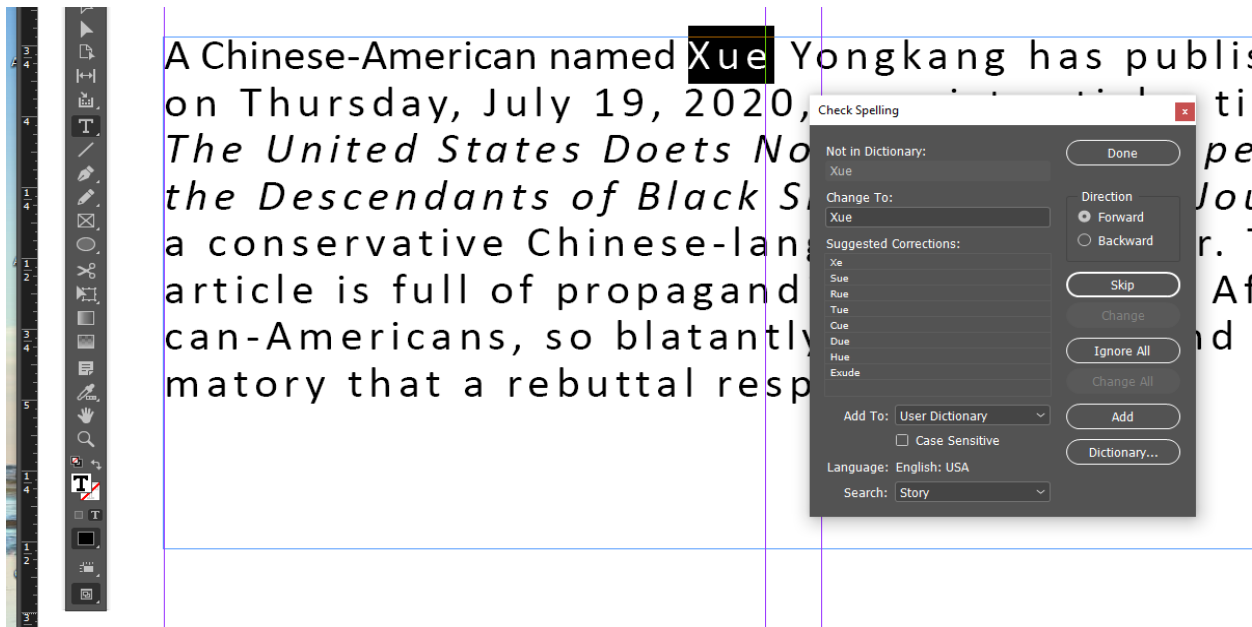


Figure 2B. The Skip button.

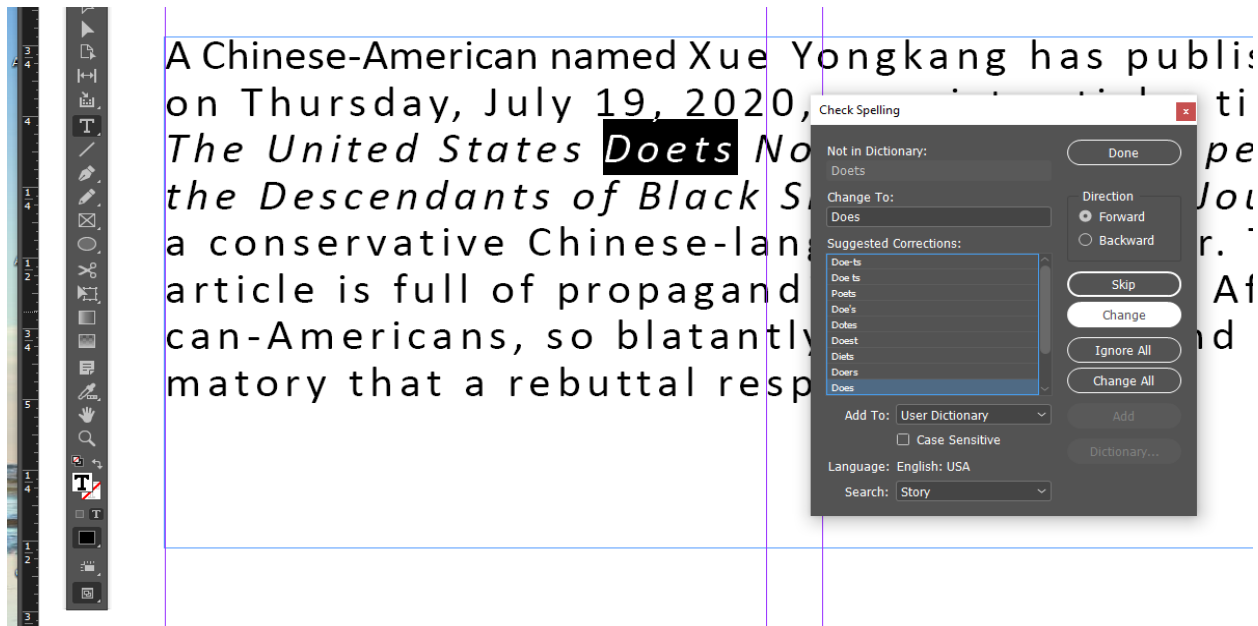


Figure 2C. The Change button.

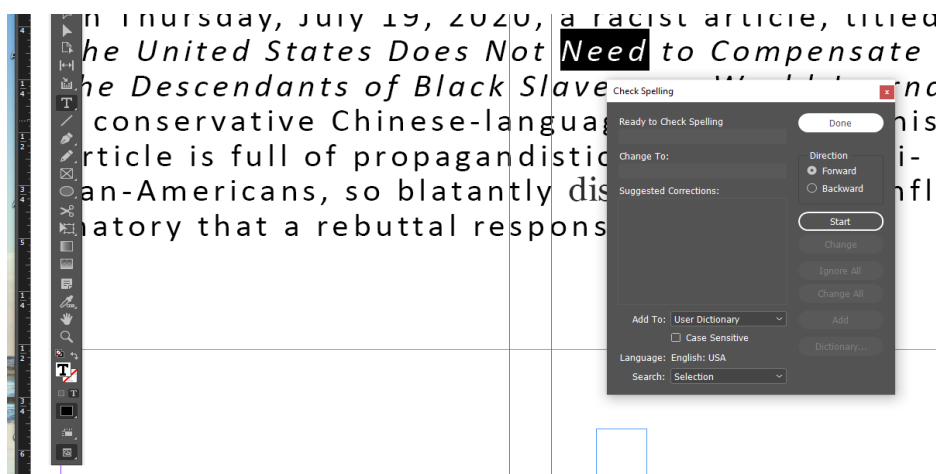


Figure 2D. The Done button.

Technique 3. To make the misspelled word highlighted when typing the text and to add your own special words to the User Dictionary

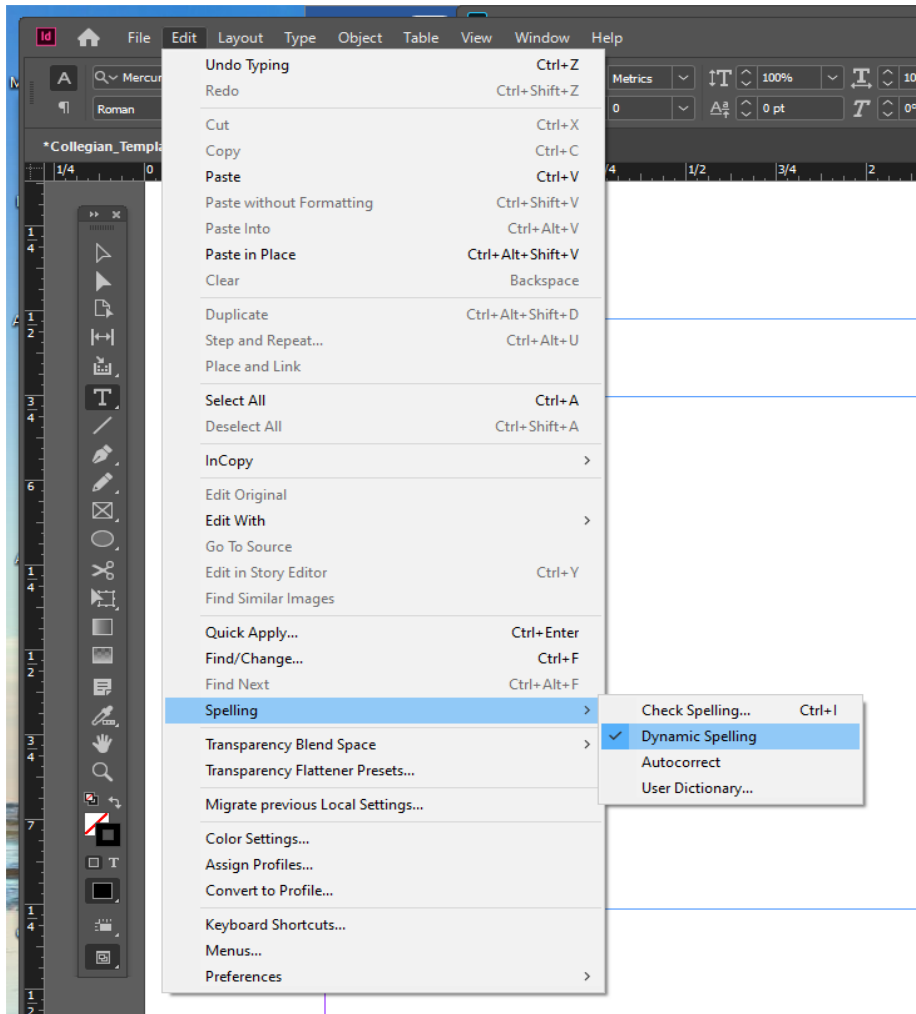


Figure 3A. Selecting the Dynamic Spelling option.

First, go to the Edit→Spelling→Dynamic Spelling, click on the left of the words Dynamic Spelling to place a checkmark (Figure 3A); this Technique will accomplish the same task as the Technique 1. Next, type a paragraph in the text frame; notice that misspelled words are highlighted with red zigzagging underlines (Figure 3B); next, while the cursor is in the misspelled word, right click for a pop-up menu and click-select the correctly spelled word (Figure 3C).

If you have specially spelled word to add to the User Dictionary, then, right-click the word for the pop-up menu and select the Add “XXX” to User Dictionary option (Figure 3D).

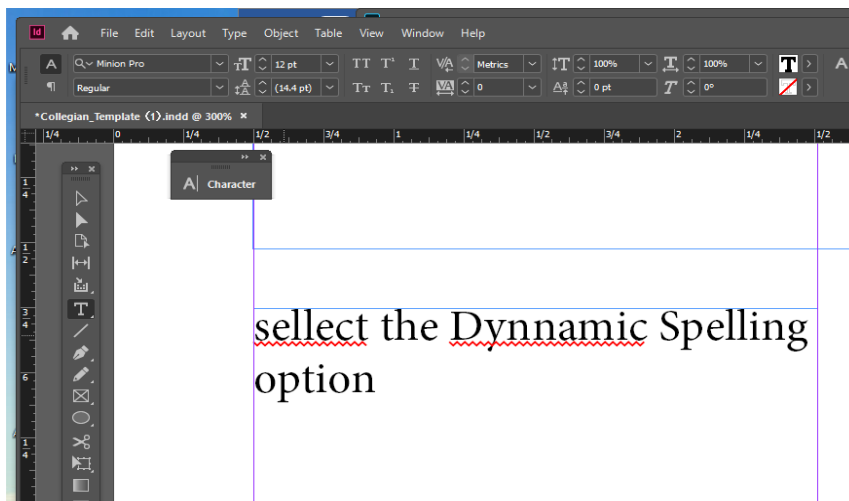


Figure 3B. Red zigzagging underlines highlighting misspelled words.

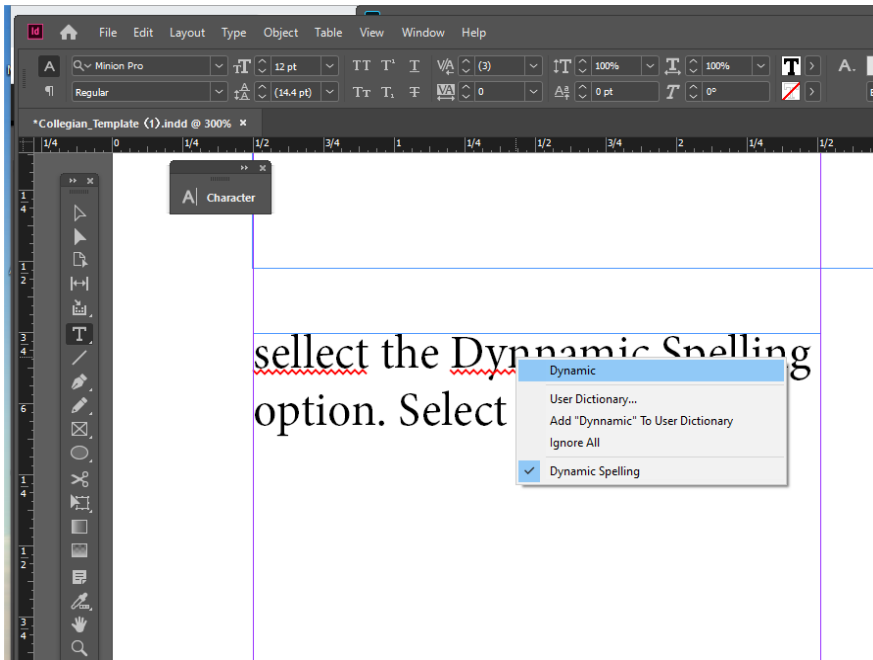


Figure 3C. Selecting the correctly spelled word from the pop-up menu.

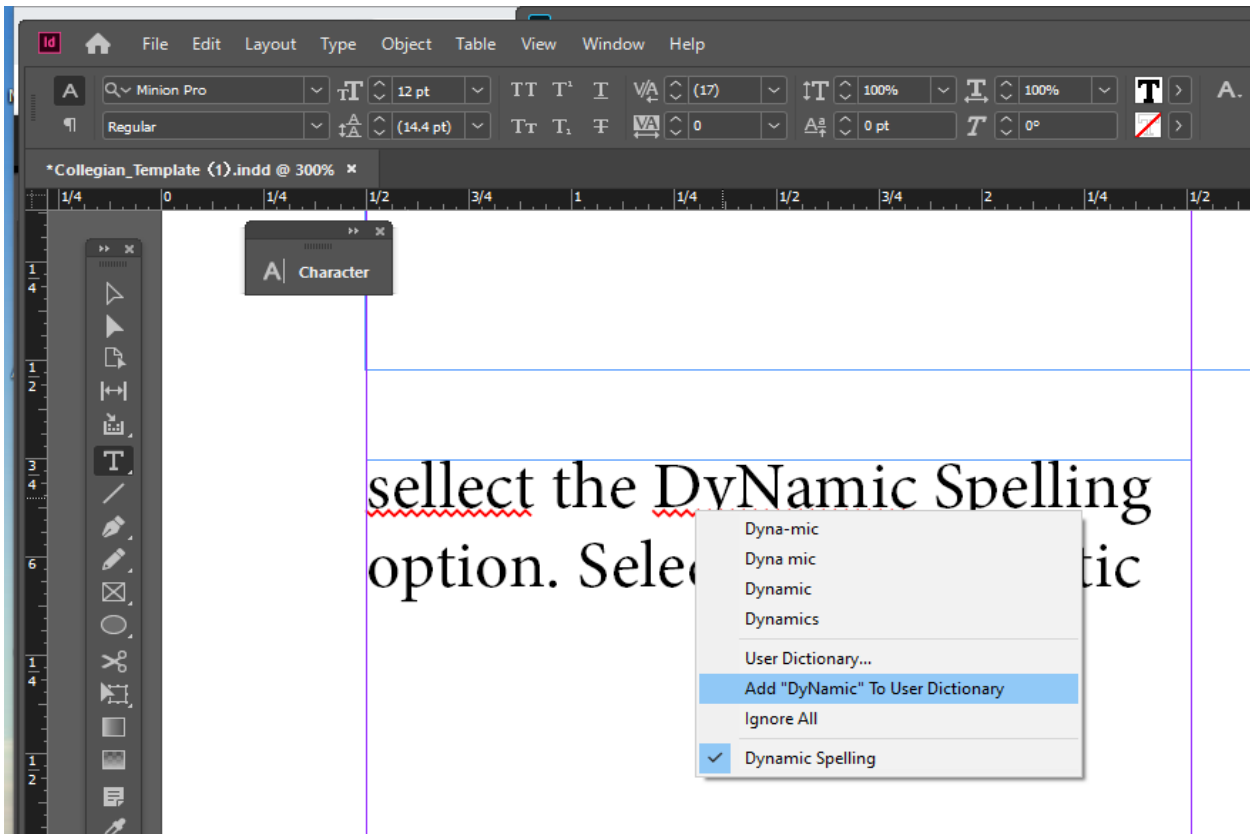


Figure 3D. Add "X word" to User Dictionary option.
